

SC: Will deploy paramilitary forces if TN doesn't clear forest encroachments

THE Supreme Court on Wednesday warned that it might be compelled to deploy paramilitary forces if encroachments within the protected areas of Tamil Nadu's Agasthyamalai ecological landscape are not removed expeditiously, as previously ordered in May. The bench also categorically stated that the cultivation of Ilavam Panju (kapok/silk cotton) in these areas must be completely abandoned. The court directed the state to file a status report in two weeks.

A bench comprising Justices Vikram Nath and Sandeep Mehta was hearing the issues concerning the protection of reserved forests, wildlife sanctuaries, and tiger reserves in

Tamil Nadu. On May 29, the court directed the state government to formulate a time-bound plan to remove encroachments from the protected areas of the Agasthyamalai ecological landscape and to implement it on a priority basis. In its order, the court noted that encroachments in the protected areas of the Agasthyamalai a i landscape—including the Kalakkad Mundanthurai Tiger Reserve, Srivilliputhur-Megamalai Tiger Reserve, and Kanyakumari Wildlife Sanctuary—had been persisting and proliferating for years. Furthermore, it ordered the initiation of both disciplinary and legal proceedings against 118 government employees—both re-

tired and serving—who were identified as encroachers in the area.

On Wednesday, the judges inquired about the measures taken so far to remove the encroachments. Jaideep Gupta, counsel appearing for the Tamil Nadu government, stated that more than 4,600 families reside within the tiger reserve forest area, and kapok is cultivated on several acres of land there. He explained that some of these families have lived in the area for generations, and measures are underway to make alternative arrangements for them before their relocation. Adding that the resorts operating within the protected forest area have been completely shut down, he requested additional time to fully

implement the court's order.

In response, the judges stated that merely closing the resorts in protected forest areas was insufficient; they must be completely removed. Similarly, they insisted that kapok cultivation in the region must be entirely abandoned and warned of deploying paramilitary forces if encroachments are not cleared. They also directed that government employees who have encroached upon the area must be removed. The judges then directed that electricity and water connections to the encroaching structures be disconnected.

The court ordered the Tamil Nadu government to file a status report in court regarding the encroachment removal process within two weeks and adjourned the hearing to September 8.

5 regional cancer care centres planned at GHs

THE ground-plus-eight-floor facility will be among five regional cancer care centres planned at government medical college hospitals in Thanjavur, Coimbatore, Madurai, Tirunelveli and Villupuram.

HPV DNA screening will be carried out for 1.22 lakh women in Dharmapuri, Villupuram, Tiruvannamalai, Perambalur and Ariyalur districts at a cost of ₹8.70 crore. Another ₹2.77 crore will be spent on training doctors and providing nutritious food to patients.

The government has also earmarked ₹106.17 crore for diagnostic tests, including radiation-related tests, Linear Accelerator facilities, and new equipment and services at government medical college hospitals.

In another major move, around 6,098 additional seats

will be created in nursing, pharmacy and allied health courses at a cost of ₹351 crore, the CM said.

Seven new government nursing colleges will be opened with 660 BSc Nursing seats, while 1,925 seats will be added to existing nursing colleges and schools. Another 2,778 seats will be created across 12 allied health courses, including physiotherapy, and 735 pharmacy seats will be added.

Services for gender-affirming surgery and treatment for transgender persons will also be expanded to Government Stanley Medical College Hospital and medical college hospitals in Tirunelveli, Thoothukudi, Chengalpattu, Tiruvallur, Dharmapuri and Kanniyakumari. The treatment will be brought under the Chief Minister's Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme.



₹1-lakh liquor meant for wedding party seized

VILLUPURAM/CUDDALORE: Police seized Puducherry liquor bottles worth around ₹1 lakh, along with a car and a motorcycle, during a vehicle check near Mailam in Villupuram district on Tuesday. A police team noticed two men travelling on a motorcycle ahead of a with 3 men car and checked both the vehicles. They found liquor bottles kept in 14 cartons, with 48 quarter bottles in each. The five persons were identified as R Murugan (26) of Tiruvannamalai, his friends S Nethraj (23) and M Dhanusu (19), both college students from the same area, M Tamilarasan (21) of Vengalathur, and A Tamilselvan (26). According to the police, Murugan had taken Nethraj and Dhanusu in his car to purchase liquor for the wedding of Tamilarasan's sister. Tamilarasan and Tamilselvan travelled on the motorcycle. Police said the group purchased the liquor from Puducherry and was taking it home. ENS

Woman murdered; hubby, his mother & sibling held

Based on their complaint, police registered a case of unnatural death.

According to sources, the woman's body had injuries on the head and near the ears, and the body was sent to Kumbakonam Government Hospital for autopsy. Mahadevi's family on Tuesday refused to receive the body demanding that her husband and in-laws be arrested for the alleged murder.

On Wednesday, Tiruvudaimarudur DSP G Azhagesan conducted an inquiry and altered the FIR and registered a case under sections 103(1) (murder), 238 (b) (causing disappearance of evidence). Meanwhile, Ramarajan surrendered before the VAO of Vittalur and confessed that he had attacked Mahadevi with a wooden log.

Police arrested Ramarajan, and also his brother Muthuraman and mother Vennila for clearing blood stains from Mahadevi's body and changing her clothes after the murder.

Continued from page 1: The minutes also record the chief secretary calling for inter-departmental coordination to prevent students and youth from participating in protests and agitations. Subsequently, on August 14, Special Secretary to Government Rashmi Siddarth Zagade forwarded the communication to the Commissioner of Collegiate Education, Director of Technical Education and registrars of universities under the higher education department. The communication was marked "most immediate" and sought an action-taken report by August 20. Asked whether the directions followed any communication from the centre, a senior government official said, "No instruction came from anywhere," but declined to elaborate. Earlier on Wednesday, members of the Students' Federation of India (SFI) staged a protest near the DCE office and were detained by police. "We want the state government to clarify why such a circular was issued naming Left parties and the BJP. We also want action against the person who ordered the circular," said SFI state secretary Samseer Ahamed.

Wife, kids left him because of alcohol addiction

Police said Parthasarathy, who worked as a contract employee at the Heavy Vehicles Factory in Avadi and earned around ₹12,000 a month, was also facing financial difficulties. His wife and two daughters got allegedly separated from him because of his drinking habit. He was also unable to send them any money, police said.

Padmavathi had been admitted to Tiruvallur Government Hospital on August 6 after falling ill and was discharged on August 16.

Parthasarathy took her home but, police said, her continued illness and dependency on him added to his frustration. She was seriously ill and unable to speak.

On Tuesday evening Parthasarathy allegedly took his mother in a wheelchair from their house to Manavur railway station. He sought the help of passengers to carry the wheelchair up the steps to the platform and took her to Platform 3, where express trains pass through. When passengers questioned him about taking his mother to the isolated platform, he allegedly told them that he was taking her to their native place.

Around 7 pm, as the Yelagiri Express approached the station, Parthasarathy allegedly pushed his mother and fled. Passersby later spotted the woman's body and alerted the railway police. Her body was sent to Arakkonam Government Hospital for postmortem.

CCTV footage from the station helped police identify Parthasarathy.

The Railway Protection Force informed the Arakkonam Government Railway Police, following which a team led by inspector Kavitha traced and arrested him near his house on Wednesday.
