NFR Announces Temporary Changes in Train Services

Assam Rising, Guwahati, October 3 : The Northeast Frontier Railway (NFR) has notified passengers that several train services will face temporary rescheduling, diversion, and regulation in view of yard remodelling works at Sevoke station under the Sevoke-Rangpo project in Alipurduar Division. The pre-non-interlocking work is scheduled for October 8 and 9, followed by non-interlocking work from Octo-

ber 10 to 15, 2025. During this period, a number of trains will run at revised timings. The Bamanhat-Siliguri Jn. DEMU will leave at 8:00 am instead of 5:00 am between October 8 and 11, while the Siliguri Jn.-New Bongaigaon DEMU will depart at 1:00 pm instead of 10:50 am on the same dates. On October 15, the New Bongaigaon-Siliguri Jn. DEMU will leave at 9:30 am in place of 6:30 am, and

the Siliguri Jn.-Bamanhat DEMU will depart at 5:30 pm instead of 4:05 pm. Similarly, the Kamakhya-Anand Vihar Terminal Express will start its journey at 6:00 am instead of 5:00 am on October 9. The Alipurduar Jn.-Delhi Sikkim Mahananda Express will depart at 1:00 pm on October 10 and at 3:00 pm on October 15, instead of the regular 10:30 am departure. The Kamakhya-Rajendra Nagar Capital Ex-

press will also be rescheduled, leaving at 8:00 am on October 10 and 10:00 am on October 15, instead of its usual 6:15 am timing.

Certain trains will also be diverted during this period. The Ara-Kamakhya Capital Express on October 14 will run via Siliguri Jn., New Jalpaiguri Jn., New Cooch Behar, New Alipurduar, and New Bongaigaon, with temporary stoppages at Jalpaiguri Road, Dhupguri, Falakata, New Cooch Behar,

and New Alipurduar. Likewise, the Udaipur City-Kamakhya Kavi Guru Express on October 13 will be diverted through New Jalpaiguri Jn., Raninagar Jalpaiguri, Dhupguri, New Cooch Behar, New Alipurduar, Samuktala Road, and New Bongaigaon, with temporary halts at Dhupguri, New Cooch Behar, and New Alipurduar.

In addition, the Delhi-Alipurduar Jn. Sikkim Mahananda Express on October 14 will be regulated in Katihar Division, while the Bamanhat-Siliguri Jn. Express on October 15 will also be suitably regulated en route.
