DON THREATENS BBC WITH \$1B LAWSUIT OVER EDITED SPEECH

Senate moves closer to ending record US govt shutdown

Accuses it of twisting his 2021 poll speech; chairman apologises for 'error of judgement'

LONDON

US President Donald Trump has threatened legal action against the BBC over the way a speech he made was edited in a documentary aired by Britain's national broadcaster.

BBC chairman Samir Shah on Monday apologised for the "error of judgement," which triggered the resignations of the BBC's top executive and its head of news, Director-General Tim Davie and news chief Deborah Turness quit on Sunday over accusations of bias and misleading editing of a speech Trump delivered on January 6, 2021, before a crowd of his supporters stormed the Capitol in Washington.

The hourlong documentary — titled "Trump: A Second

Chance?" — was broadcast as part of the BBC's "Panorama" series days before the 2024 US presidential election. It spliced together three quotes from two sections of the 2021 speech, delivered almost an hour apart, into what appeared to be one quote in which Trump urged supporters to march with him and "fight like hell." Among the parts cut out was a section where Trump said he wanted supporters to demonstrate peacefully.

Shah said the broadcaster accepted "that the way the speech was edited did give the impression of a direct call for violent action." A letter from Trump

attorney Alejandro Brito demands the BBC "retract the false, defamatory, disparaging, and inflammatory statements," apologise and "appropriately compensate President Trump for the harm caused," or face legal action for \$1 billion in damages. The BBC said it would review the letter "and respond directly in due course."

Trump had earlier welcomed the resignations of the two BBC executives. He posted a link to a Daily Telegraph story about the speech-editing on his Truth Social network, thanking the newspaper "for exposing these Corrupt Journalists." These are very

dishonest people who tried to step on the scales of a Presidential Election." He called that "a terrible thing for Democracy!"

In a resignation letter to staff, Davie said: "There have been some mistakes made and as director-general I have to take ultimate responsibility."

Turness said the controversy was damaging the BBC, and she quit "because the buck stops with me." She defended the organisation's journalists against allegations of bias.

"Our journalists are hard-working people who strive for impartiality, and I will stand by their journalism," she said Monday. "There is no institutional bias. Mistakes are made, but there's no institutional bias." AP

THE US Senate took a major step toward ending the longest government shutdown in American history when it cleared the way for a formal debate on a motion to resume funding to federal agencies.

The development represents significant progress toward ending a government shutdown that has dragged on for over 40 days, halted funding to federal programs and disrupted air travel and other essential industries. The breakthrough late on Sunday came after Republican and Democratic lawmakers reached a stopgap agreement to fund the government through January, after wrangling over healthcare subsidies, food benefits and Trump's firings of federal employees.

Following the deal the Republican-led chamber approved a procedural vote by 60 votes to

40, putting a hard limit on how much longer senators can discuss the legislative measure.

It gave lawmakers a maximum of 30 more hours to conduct debate before voting on the motion, which will only need 50 votes to pass. It will still need approval from the Republican-controlled House of Representatives before it lands on President Donald Trump's desk — a process which could take days. As the news emerged, Trump told reporters when he arrived at the White House af-

ter a weekend at his Mar-a-Lago estate in Florida: "It looks like we're getting very close to the shutdown ending."

Democratic Senator Tim Kaine of Virginia was among the eight who joined Republicans to support the measure, saying: "I need a moratorium on the punishing of the federal workforce." Virginia is home to 300,000 federal workers, and the deal would restore all furloughed employees and reverse reductions-in-force layoffs by the Trump administration. The bill to keep the government funded at pre-shutdown levels "will protect federal workers from baseless firings, reinstate those who have been wrongfully terminated during the shutdown, and ensure federal workers receive back pay" as required by law, Kaine added. Fellow Democrat Chuck Schumer could not be persuaded and voted against the measure. AFP

Typhoon Fung-wong leaves 8 dead in Philippines

MANILA

TYPHOON Fung-wong blew out of the north-western Philippines on Monday after setting off floods and landslides, knocking out power to entire provinces, killing at least eight people and displacing more than 1.4 million others.

The typhoon was forecast to head northwest toward Taiwan. Fung-wong lashed the northern Philippines while the country was still dealing with the devastation wrought last week by Typhoon Kalmaegi, which left at least 224 people dead in central provinces on November 4 before pummeling Vietnam, where at least five were killed.

Fung-wong slammed ashore in northeastern Aurora province on Sunday night as a super typhoon with sustained winds of up to 185 kph and gusts of up to 230 kph. The 1,800-kilometer-wide storm weakened as it raked through mountainous northern provinces and agricultural plains overnight before blowing away from the province of La Union into the South China Sea, according to state forecasters.

One person drowned in flash floods in the eastern province of Catanduanes, and another died in Catbalogan city in eastern Samar province when her house collapsed on her, officials said. AP

31 inmates killed in jail riot in Ecuador

QUITO

AUTHORITIES said at least 27 inmates were found dead by asphyxiation Sunday afternoon at an Ecuadorian prison where an armed riot left four others dead and dozens injured in the morning.

In a statement, prison authorities said the 27 individuals found dead at the Machala prison in El Oro province had "among themselves committed asphyxiation, which caused immediate death by suspension." Authorities said they were still working to "fully clarify the facts," and forensic medical personnel were on site to verify information. AFP

China woos global tech talent with new K-visa

HONG KONG: Vaishnavi Srinivasagopalan, a skilled Indian IT professional who has worked in both India and the US, has been looking for work in China. Beijing's new K-visa programme targeting science and technology workers could turn that dream into a reality. The K-visa rolled out by Beijing last month is part of China's widening effort to catch up with the US in the race for global talent and cutting edge technology. It coincides with uncertainties over the US's H-1B programme under tightened immigration policies implemented by Donald Trump. "The K-visa for China (is) an equivalent to the H-1B for the US," said Srinivasagopalan, who is intrigued by China's working environment and culture after her father worked at a Chinese university a few years back.
