Nambiyar Nagar residents stage protest

More than 500 residents of Nambiyar Nagar fishing village laid siege to the Nagapattinam Collectorate on Friday demanding basic amenities, bringing traffic around the office to a halt for hours.

Residents of the area said they had long sought proper roads, drainage, drinking water supply, street lights and house site pattas. They wanted the access to the newly built community hall and cyclone shelter opened as the keys are with the municipality, and diesel and ice plants at the Nambiyar Nagar fishing harbour.

in seven to ten days, and even that is often muddy,"

told The Hindu. protest began The around 9 a.m. in front of the Collectorate, where police erected barricades and closed the main gate; revenue officials later held talks with the protesters, but residents insisted that the Collector give a categorical assurance.

Former AIADMK Minister O.S. Manian, TVK district secretary Sugumar and BJP cadre visited the spot to express support.

The agitation was withdrawn around 2.30 p.m. Later, in the evening the District Collector assured to initiate action to address their grievances.

copra prices, say farmers The Hindu Bureau The East Coast Coconut

Farmers' Association (EC-FA), Peravurani, has alleged that the price of copra and coconut prices in Tamil Nadu are being artificially kept low by a private company amid reduced production and rising demand. In a statement here on

Thursday, ECFA president E.V. Gandhi said pest attacks and continuous rain had sharply hit yields in key coconut belts such as Pollachi, Coimbatore, Pattukkottai, and Peravurani in Thanjavur district as well as in parts of Kerala. Under normal conditions, lower output should have pushed prices up, he said.

"Within a week, copra prices have fallen from about ₹262 a kg to ₹192 a kg, without any genuine increase in arrivals," he alleged. Traders and farmers

were being told that "large volumes of copra loads" were coming into the market, though this was not borne out by conditions on the ground, he added

Mr. Gandhi said a farmer in Peravurani, who earlier sold coconuts at ₹35-₹37 per nut, was now compelled to accept ₹30 as the rates were being benchmarked to prices in Kangavam, where corporatelinked procurement was stronger.

The association pointed out that Kerala's cooperative agency Kerafed had acknowledged that local production was insufficient and that the State depended on Tamil Nadu for its requirement of coconuts and coconut oil, including bulk orders of around 100 tonnes a day. "When Kerala is short of coconuts and is turning to Tamil Nadu, it is illogical to claim surplus production as the reason for a price crash," Mr. Gandhi said.

If this "manipulation of prices" continued, ECFA has threatened to launch a Statewide agitation, including calls to boycott products made from Tamil Nadu coconuts by the concerned company, social media campaigns, and protests in front of its offices. The association has urged the State government and the Agriculture Marketing and Agri Business Department to intervene and ensure fair, transparent price discovery for coconut growers.

TRRI holds 26-day 'Seed Grower' skill training for farmers

The Tamil Nadu Rice Research Institute (TRRI), Aduthurai, has completed a 26-day residential skill training programme in scientific seed production for rural youth.

The on-campus course, titled "Seed Grower", was held from October 13 to November 19 for 25 youth from Thanjavur district. Funded by the Tamil Nadu Skill Development Corporation (TNSDC) under the "Vetri Nichayam" scheme for people in the 18-35 age group, the programme concluded with a final assessment at the institute on November 24.

According to institute officials, the training aimed to prepare participants as seed production entrepreneurs. They were taken to a seed storage godown, Food Corporation of India facility, seed testing laboratory, and a farmer producer company in Thanjavur to familiarise them with institutional systems and business opportunities. Under the TNSDC Skill

Voucher Programme, eligible candidates receive vouchers of up to ₹12,000 to offset training costs, and those from vulnerable groups are eligible for an additional incentive of ₹6,000, credited through Direct Benefit Transfer on successful completion. Assessment was through a mobile application-based system with Aadhaar validation, followed by one-to-one viva voce by a TNSDC-nominated assessor. All 25 candidates passed and received merit certificates.

Director K. Subrahmaniyan said the institute would now focus on facilitating placements.
