

Udhaya accuses BJP of 'vote theft' and attempting to weaken political outfits

DEPUTY Chief Minister Udhayanidhi Stalin on Friday accused the BJP of engaging in "vote theft" and "party theft", alleging that the party was attempting to weaken regional outfits and diminish the state's political representation through delimitation.

Addressing a consultation meeting of DMK branch secretaries and booth agents at Gingee in Villupuram district on Friday night, Udhayanidhi said the Dravidian Model government's victory in 2021 was the result of relentless work by party cadres. "Our chief minister is guiding Tamil Nadu. With 11.19% growth, the State has emerged as a leader in the country," he said.

He criticised the union government for creating obstacles for Tamil Nadu, including the push for the National Education Policy (NEP). "If the NEP is accepted, Hindi will re-enter Tamil Nadu and Sanskrit will be imposed. Because we rejected the policy, Union Minister Dharmendra Pradhan is refusing to release ₹2,500 crore," he alleged.

Udhayanidhi said the Union government was moving towards delimitation, warning that Tamil Nadu's Lok Sabha constituencies could be reduced because the State had successfully controlled population growth. "They are taking steps only to deny Tamil Nadu its rights," he said.

Referring to the SIR amend-

ment issue, he alleged that the BJP's intention was to take away the votes of marginalised communities. He criticised AIADMK general secretary Edappadi K Palaniswami for supporting the amendment, claiming he had "no other choice". "AIADMK functions as a branch of the BJP," he said, adding that several AIADMK

leaders were acting under the direction of Union Home Minister Amit Shah.

"The BJP is now involved in vote theft and party theft. It is going to swallow the AIADMK completely," he alleged. He said the union government was functioning with the idea of "one election, one religion, one language, one party", and that Chief Minister M K Stalin was leading a major democratic struggle against it.

Udhayanidhi urged DMK cadres to intensify door-to-door campaigning and address people's concerns, expressing confidence that the DMK alliance would win more than 200 seats in the upcoming elections.

Earlier on Saturday, Udhayanidhi distributed welfare assistance to 25 beneficiaries at the Government Law College, Villupuram, under schemes including the Annal Ambedkar Industrial Pioneers Scheme and the chief minister's Adiravadar and Social-Economic Entrepreneurship Scheme. A total of ₹119.70 crore was sanctioned for 9,230 beneficiaries. He later paid floral tributes to B R Ambedkar on the occasion of his remembrance day at Kallaignar Arivalayam.

Ex-Pondy CM demands CBI probe into ₹2,000 crore fake-drug racket

FORMER Puducherry chief minister and senior Congress leader V Narayanasamy has petitioned Lieutenant Governor K Kailashnathan, seeking the immediate transfer of the large-scale fake drug manufacturing case from the CBCID to the CBI, alleging political interference and intimidation of officials.

The case emerged after Sun Pharma lodged a complaint that counterfeit medicines carrying its brand name were being produced in Puducherry. Acting on the complaint, the CBCID raided a godown at the Mettupalayam Industrial Estate and seized spurious drugs worth ₹40 crore.

Narayanasamy said prelimi-

nary investigations suggested that the unit, allegedly run by Raja of Reddiarpalayam, had been operating for nearly four-and-a-half years without GST registration, industrial licences, pollution clearance or mandatory drug manufacturing approvals. After arresting two employees, Rana and Meiyappan, the CBCID unearthed an-

other major illegal facility at Thirubhuvanai, where fake medicines and raw materials valued at ₹450 crore were recovered. The unit, believed to have been acquired by Raja, was allegedly running without medical licences and is suspected to have produced drugs worth over ₹2,000 crore, allegedly distributed across several states.

15.96 cr welfare aid distributed on Ambedkar death anniversary

A total of 1,901 beneficiaries in Cuddalore district received government welfare assistance worth ₹15.96 crore on Saturday, marking the 69th death anniversary of Dr B R Ambedkar. Ministers MRK Panneerselvam and C Ve Ganesan distributed the benefits at the Municipal Hall in Manjakuppam.

Organised by the Adi Dravidar and Tribal Welfare Depart-

ment, the event followed the chief minister's programme in Chennai.

Panneerselvam said 13,262 beneficiaries had received agricultural machinery worth ₹142 crore in the past four-and-a-half years, while 2,114 individuals were given deep borewells at full subsidy.

In Cuddalore, 180 people received sewing machines and 44 received washing machines. Senior officials participated in the event.

Child drowns in pond, elder brother rescued

CUDDALORE: A two-and-a-half-year-old boy drowned in a pond near Cuddalore on Friday, while his elder brother was rescued. Police said Anantharajan and Kousalya of Suthukulam had left their children, Akhileswaran, four, and Yuvaneshwaran, two-and-a-half,



playing near a pond when they slipped in while chasing a kitten. Neighbours pulled out Akhileswaran immediately, but the younger child could not be located at first. Residents later recovered him and rushed him to the Cuddalore GH, where he was declared dead. Akhileswaran is undergoing treatment. A case has been registered. ENS

Puducherry: The 29th National Book Fair, organised by the Puducherry Writers' Book Society, will be held at the Vel Sokkanathan Wedding Hall from December 19 to 28. Addressing reporters on Saturday, Co-operative Book Society president Panch Ramalingam said 22 new titles by Puducherry-based writers will be released. Chief Minister N Rangasamy will inaugurate the fair, with Speaker R Selvam presiding. Around 100 publishers from Puducherry, Tamil Nadu, Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh, Mumbai and Delhi will participate. The fair will feature more than 60,000 titles, including a special stall for Puducherry authors. All books carry a 10% discount. The venue will be open from 11 am to 8 pm, with a book-purchase lucky draw. ENS

Three Cuddalore fishermen swim to safety after boat capsizes



Cuddalore: Three fishermen from Thazhanguda in Cuddalore swam to safety on Friday after their fibre boat capsized in rough seas. Local fishermen said sea conditions off the Cuddalore coast have remained unsettled even after fishing resumed on December 3, following a ten-day halt due to Cyclone Ditwah. On Friday morning, Raghavendran, Divakar and Natarajan ventured into deep sea, but strong winds waves overturned their vessel around noon. The trio leapt into the water and swam back to shore. A separate team later went out to retrieve the capsized boat. A fishing net worth ₹1 lakh was washed away in the incident. ENS
