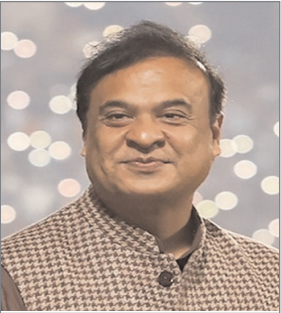


# India-EU trade deal to be a game changer: Assam CM at Davos

DAVOS : The trade deal between India and the European Union (EU) is going to be a game-changer as they share strong and trusted ties, with growing cooperation across sectors, Assam Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma said on Wednesday.

Speaking to IANS on the sidelines of the World Economic Forum (WEF) annual meeting here, Sarma said that our companies need access to different markets, and this need will be fulfilled with the upcoming India-EU trade deal.

"Europe clearly sees India as a dependable partner,



which is evident from recent statements by the European Union leadership. The European Union's own speeches underline India's emergence as a major global

investment hub. India's stable policies and fast-growing economy are attracting sustained European investments and partnerships," Sarma told IANS.

The India-EU Summit, scheduled for January 27, comes as part of the steady strengthening of economic relations between the two sides amid growing uncertainties in global markets triggered by the US tariff turmoil and dramatic geopolitical shifts in the world order.

Sarma said that the IMF has just revised India's growth target, projecting a growth rate of 7.3 per cent

for FY26.

"India will soon become the third-largest economy in terms of GDP and has many other advantages," he noted.

"India is a mature democracy with consistency and patience. So, even if one or two strategies don't work, we should not be worried because we can diversify and explore other markets. Our economy has many strengths, and we have a large domestic market," he mentioned.

Sarma said that this is the first time "we have come to Davos". "Our responsibility was to introduce global leaders to Assam. People are lis-

tening to us and are committing to invest," he told IANS.

Earlier, Sarma said that the state is proactively preparing its workforce for an increasingly automated and Artificial Intelligence (AI)-driven future, leveraging its young demographic advantage and focusing on industry-aligned skill development.

Speaking at the WEF annual meeting during an earlier event, CM Sarma shared how Assam is reshaping its skillng ecosystem to meet the demands of emerging technologies and future-ready industries.

## India and Spain must pool resources and capabilities to fight terrorism: President Murmu

NEW DELHI : President Droupadi Murmu on Wednesday stated that India and Spain must pool their resources and capabilities to fight terrorism in all its forms and manifestations as both countries have a shared position on countering the menace, which remains a common threat to global peace and stability.

President Murmu made these remarks as Spain's Minister of Foreign Affairs, European Union and Cooperation Jose Manuel Albares called on her at Rashtrapati Bhavan in New Delhi. She also stated that India and Spain must work together on multilateral platforms like the United Nations and G20 to further their shared goals of peace, prosperity and stability across the world.

President Murmu said that India and Spain will mark the 70th anniversary of diplomatic relations this year by celebrating the 'India-Spain Dual Year of Culture, Tourism and Artificial Intelligence', according to a statement released by the Rashtrapati Bhavan following the meeting. Highlighting the economic ties between two nations, President Murmu stated that India and Spain have a steadily growing economic relationship, with increasing trade and investment. She noted that Spain's strengths in engineering, railways, renewable energy, urban services, and defence aerospace complement India's development priorities. She expressed confidence that trade ties between

India and Spain will be strengthened with the signing of Free Trade Agreement (FTA) between India and European Union.

"Minister of Foreign Affairs, European Union and Cooperation of Spain Mr Jose Manuel Albares called on President Droupadi Murmu at Rashtrapati Bhavan. The President expressed happiness at the launch of the 'India-Spain Dual Year of Culture, Tourism and Artificial Intelligence', which will showcase the strong cultural bonds and people-to-people affinity, tourism avenues, and deepening technological collaborations between India and Spain," President's Secretariat posted on X. Earlier in the day, Jose Manuel Albares held a meeting with External .

KOCHI : The Kerala High Court on Wednesday came down heavily on former Travancore Devaswom Board (TDB) member K.P. Sankaradas, who is in judicial custody in connection with the Sabarimala gold misappropriation case, even as the Enforcement Directorate (ED) widened its probe into what it described as a well-orchestrated money-laundering operation involving temple assets.

The court directed the constitution of a medical board to assess Sankaradas's health condition and examine whether his treatment could continue while he is lodged in jail. It ordered that the report be submitted in a sealed cover. Sankaradas is currently undergoing treatment at the Thiruvananthapuram Medical College Hospital.

Sankaradas, the 11th accused in the case, was sent to custody after a Kollam Vigilance Court judge visited a private hospital where he had been admitted.

The High Court had earlier sharply criticised the delay in his arrest, remarking that he continued to remain hospitalised because his son is

an IPS officer. Following the court's strong observations, the Special Investigation Team (SIT) formally recorded his arrest, after which he was shifted to the Medical College Hospital under jail custody.

Meanwhile, the ED's Kochi Zonal Office, invoking provisions of the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA), 2002, conducted searches on January 20 at 21 locations across Kerala, Tamil Nadu and Karnataka.

The probe, based on two FIRs registered by the Kerala

Police Crime Branch, has uncovered a criminal conspiracy allegedly involving senior TDB officials, former temple administrators, private sponsors, and jewellers.

According to the ED, sacred gold-clad artefacts of the Sabarimala temple, including Dwarapalaka idol components, pedestals and sanctum sanctorum door panels, were falsely recorded as "copper plates" between 2019 and 2025 and removed without authorisation.

These were transported to

private facilities in Chennai and Karnataka, where gold was chemically extracted under the guise of repair work. The ED seized incriminating documents, digital evidence and a 100-gram gold bar, and froze eight immovable properties of the prime accused worth about Rs 1.3 crore. The agency said investigations are continuing to trace the proceeds of crime and identify further beneficiaries.

## Mahayuti tension: Shiv Sena's twin strategy triggers pressure politics, Fadnavis adopts wait-and-watch stance

MUMBAI : The Mahayuti alliance in Maharashtra is witnessing a sharp escalation in internal friction as Eknath Shinde's Shiv Sena appears to be deploying a sophisticated dual strategy to assert dominance over the BJP in local civic bodies. The recent political manoeuvres in the Kalyan-Dombivli and Ulhasnagar municipal corporations have sent ripples through the ruling coalition, prompting a cautious wait-and-watch approach from Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis.

In a move that surprised both allies and opponents, Shinde's Shiv Sena has secured support from the Maharashtra Navnirman Sena (MNS) in Kalyan-Dombivli, effectively sidelining the BJP.

By consolidating 62 seats, the Shinde faction is positioned to establish power without relying on its primary senior partner, the BJP. This shift has not only sidelined the BJP but also served as a strategic blow to Uddhav Thackeray's Shiv Sena (UBT). Similar tactics are unfolding in Ulhasnagar. Under the leadership of Shinde Sena MP Dr Shrikant Shinde, the party is actively courting independent corporators and two members of the Vanchit Bahujan Aghadi (VBA). With both the BJP and Shinde Sena currently tied at 37 seats each, Shinde is pushing to reach the magic figure of 40 to install a Shiv Sena Mayor, potentially leaving the BJP in the lurch.

Political analysts suggest these moves are a direct tit-for-tat response to recent events in Ambernath and Badlapur. In Ambernath, the BJP had reportedly aligned with Congress corporators to secure the presidency, keeping the Shinde faction at bay. Shinde responded by aligning with Ajit Pawar's NCP to secure the vice-presidency. The current aggressive posturing in KDMC is seen as a strategic repayment.
